BUILD A PHOTO BOARD

Present your project through a **photo board** – a collection of photos arranged to explore a topic, issue, question or puzzle. Ensure that you include text explanations with the photos you use.

- You can use **PowerPoint** or **Google Slides** to create your photo board.
- Alternatively, create one large photo board with an online photo collage maker like **Canva** at www.canva.com/templates/ or **Photo Collage** at www.photocollage.com.
- You can also choose to use a Photovoice approach. Your photos should be planned so they document places, people or scenes that represent aspects of your project question. Your photos should be able to be used to express your point of view or represent your community.

Photovoice is a process in which photo images (or videos) are used to capture aspects of a person's environment and experiences and share them with others. Captions are used to share these aspects and to motivate change. Make sure you provide captions or reflections for at least five of your photos.

- Take photos that illustrate the elements of a food policy strategy or idea, that present the myths and facts involved in one aspect of food or farming, that map farming or sustainability practices or profile the work and accomplishments of a farmer.
- Submit your photo board as a PDF, JPEG, GIF or PNG file, or provide a URL for an online project.

OR USE YOUR OWN IDEA

Develop your own project format. You may decide you'd rather do an essay, a comic book or strip, a graphic novel or a poster. You may have your own ideas. Get the go-ahead from your teacher before you start.
